E-Learning Code of Conduct

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of our curriculum we encourage pupils to make use of educational resources available on the internet. We also provide pupils with access to the Virtual Learning Environment. Access to the Internet enables pupils to conduct research and obtain high quality educational resources from libraries, museums, galleries and other information sources from around the world.

To guard against accidental access to materials which are inappropriate in school, all Oxfordshire schools access the Internet and the Virtual Learning Environment. However, it is not possible to provide a 100% insurance that pupils might not accidentally come across material which would be inappropriate.

Therefore, before they access the Internet we would like all pupils to discuss the attached E-Learning Code of Conduct with their parents/guardians and then return the signed form to the school office. Please detach the signed form and return that sheet but keep the rest of the document for you to refer to.

We believe that the educational benefits to pupils from access to the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, far outweigh the potential disadvantages.

During lesson time teachers will guide pupils toward specific materials and educational resources. Where pupils are given permission to access the Internet outside lessons they must agree to access only those sites that are appropriate for use in school and use the e-learning resources appropriately.
