Message from the Head Teacher

It was wonderful to see Parent Consultations so well attended. I know the teachers found the opportunity to discuss the progress, attainment and well-being of your children very useful.

As the Y2 and Y6 SATs draw nearer It is important that your child attends school as regularly as possible over the coming weeks. Although we try to make the process as stress free as possible some children do sometimes become worried over the tests. It is important to remember they don't involve a pass or fail, they just reflect how well the child has understood what they're learning at school. The more relaxed you are, the better your child will be able to tackle the test.

Coats

Although the days have started to brighten up it is still cold at playtimes. We would request that you still send your child to school with a coat for the time being.

Living Eggs

This month we welcome some very special guests to school, Living Eggs! The eggs are 19 days old when they arrive and are normally ready to hatch on day 20 or 21. The Living Eggs incubators are specially designed for classroom hatching. An electronic thermostat ensures accurate temperature control and the large viewing windows allow the children to see all stages of hatching. A brooder box complete with heat, light, bedding, feed and water is supplied which allows teachers and children easy observation and access to the chicks.
