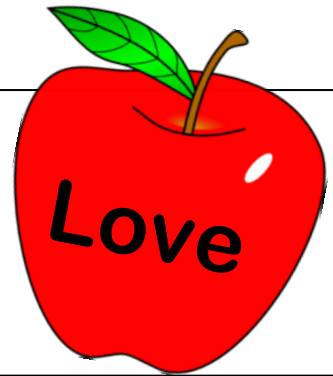
Contact Details
