Make a tourist leaflet for people visiting Australia's Great Barrier Reef.

Draw the view of the ocean you might see if you were looking through the window of a submersible.

Create a picture dictionary of plants and creatures of the ocean.

Find out about and create a fact file for unusual marine animals such as the deep-sea angler fish, the gulper eel or the Greenland shark. Include information about the adaptations that help them survive in a particular ocean or zone.
