


## Emperors and Empires

This half term we'll be exploring Roman warriors and investigate the Roman Empire and its effect on Britain, including why the Celts fought back. Using maps, globes and information books we will compare Britain (home of the Celts) and Rome (home of the Romans).

Research 3 of the following Roman Gods; Jupiter, Diana, Pluto, Mars and Juno. Present your findings, e.g. as a fact file, presentation or poster.

Research an Ancient Roman or Celt recipe. Have a go at making one, take some pictures and re-write the recipe. Be a critic and give the dish a rating out of 10.

plebeians and freed people                  equites

Write a short paragraph to describe the different roles that these people played in Roman society.
