

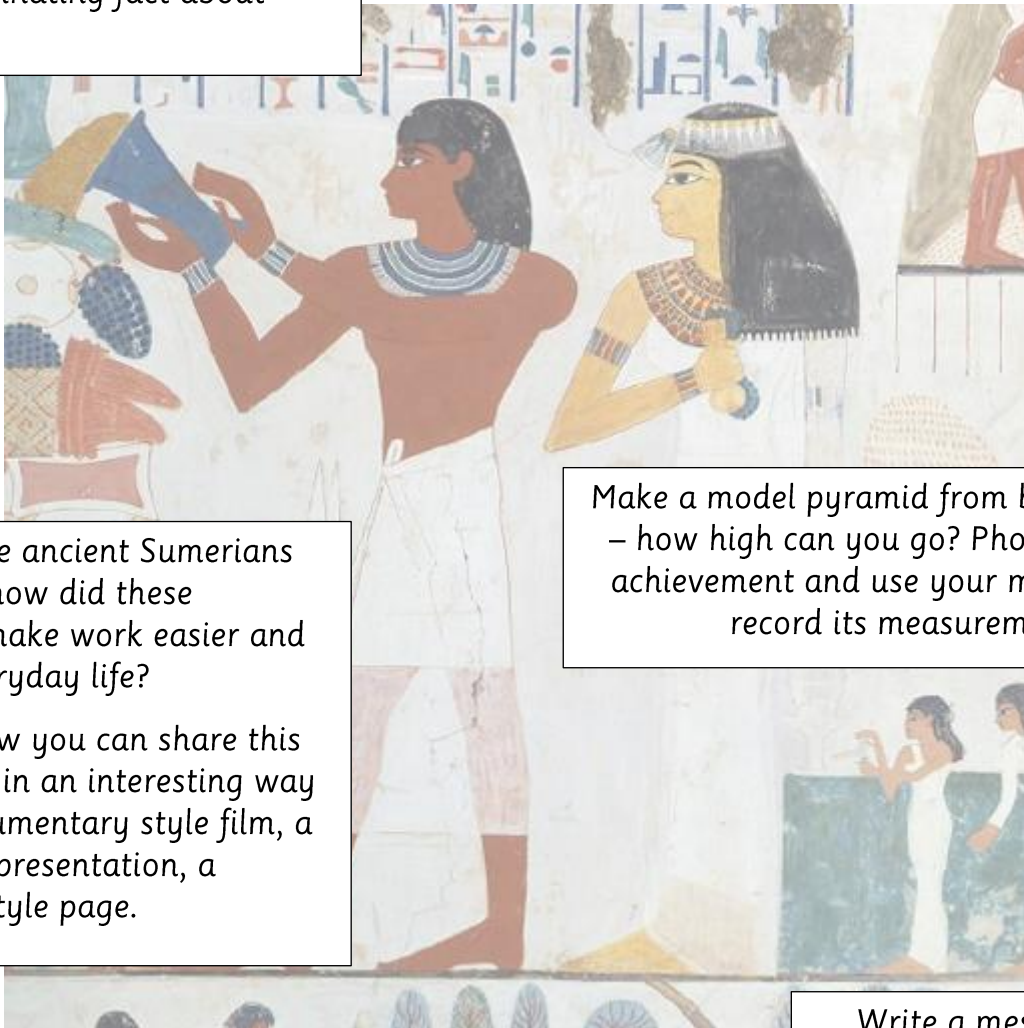
## Summer Term 2024

Ancient Civilisations teaches children about the history of two of the first three ancient civilisations: ancient Sumer and ancient Egypt. Children will learn about how crucial factors like water sources and farming helped them to develop and thrive. They will find out about important inventions, the growth of cities and different people in society, including the roles of kings and pharaohs.

Choose **two** of the following tasks to complete over the course of the term. Please complete them in your learning-log book and hand them in by **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July**.

Research pharaohs of ancient Egypt. Choose two that you find interesting, draw each of them, record the dates of their reign and write a fascinating fact about each one.

Make flatbread and serve it to your family with authentic Egyptian dips or salads. Find out more about the food of Ancient Egypt.



Make a model pyramid from building blocks – how high can you go? Photograph your achievement and use your maths skills to record its measurements.

What did the ancient Sumerians invent and how did these inventions make work easier and improve everyday life?

Consider how you can share this information in an interesting way – e.g. a documentary style film, a PowerPoint presentation, a scrapbook style page.

Design and have a go at making Egyptian or Sumerian style jewellery. Use The British Museum or The Met Museum's websites to help you find some inspiration.

Write a message to a friend or family using hieroglyphs. Can they crack the code?
